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## Mission

The mission is to design a common and inclusive approach that makes possible the practice of sport both for children "with disabilities" and for the so-called "able-bodied" children.

PLAYINC is also a network composed of grassroots sports organizations that share a common methodology in order to provide inclusive sports activities.

We believe that managing complex needs requires a constant development of skills and knowledge by coaches and volunteers.

We propose guidelines on how to adapt and manage sports aimed at promoting social inclusion between children with motor and cognitive disabilities and able-bodied children up to 13 years.

## PLAYINC Sport Activities

The activities were conceived and designed with the aim of addressing the needs of coaches and families, which were directly analyzed through questionnaires.
